

Starburst Sweatshirt Jacket- Supply List- Peggy Supplee

Sweatshirt - needs to have set-in sleeves. Wash and preshrink. After the sweatshirt is washed, make sure that it is large enough to fit comfortably. Usually buying 1 size larger than you usually wear works well.

1/2 yd each of 9 different coordinating fabrics

1 1/2 yds fabric in a contrasting color (you may use a fabric that matches your sweatshirt)

1 zipper 22 inches works well

Straight pins

evaporating Marking pen

6" ruler

24" ruler

scissors

zipper foot

thread to match your sweatshirt

sewing machine in good working condition

Pre-class Preparation:

Wash and preshrink sweatshirt. I have suggested that you buy 1/2 yd of 9 coordinating fabrics; it will not take this much fabric but sometimes the fabric is not straight and you might run out if you have less. Before class, cut two, 3" strips of each color the width of the fabric. Cut 24 strips of contrast fabric 1" wide, the width of the fabric. Iron the 1" pieces in half length wise, right side out. Try to get these strips pressed evenly. The rest of the fabric will be used for the binding. Do not cut these yet.
