You will be making a 4-block sampler quilted wall hanging, learn about fabric, color and quilting equipment; rotary cutting; strip piecing; half-square and quarter-square triangle units; inset piecing; sashing; completing the quilt top; putting the layers together; and quilting. The blocks we will be doing are: Jacob's ladder, Ohio Star, Spools and Card Trick

FRACTURED RHAPSODY (Bargello) 2012

Instructor: Liz Buchanan

VALUE, VALUE, VALUE!! (of color) This is the most important aspect of a bargello. The easiest way to start is to select a multi-colored fabric, and then start pulling fabrics to match. Choose light, medium and dark tones in all of the colors, even duplicating some. Line all the fabrics up by value (*lightest to darkest), not by color! Look at them in a dark room, or use a value-finder tool. Eliminate a fabric that is too close in value to its neighbor. Whittle down to 15 fabrics. Cut a ¼" strip of each fabric and line them up again, and fix any value misplacements!

HEIRLOOM TECHNIQUES FOR BABY QUILT 2012

Words are almost inadequate to describe this beautiful heirloom quilt by Martha Pullen. Made of white and ecru 100% cotton Victorian batiste, this quilt should last forever. There are touches of color in the machine embroidery and in the underlinings of some of the designs and in the ribbons on the crazy patch square. The techniques in the quilt, other than the construction, are circular puffing, circular lace shaping, cathedral windows, shadow gimp work, double needle pintucks, diamond lace shaping, Madeira motifs, crazy patch ovals and Normandy lace shaping. Any one of the quilt squares would be just gorgeous as a pillow.
